Fees for Clinical Services

My fees are consistent with governmental guidelines suggested by the Health Care Financing Administration (HCFA), reimbursement schedules of most insurance companies, and with those charged by other local psychologists. My contract with individual insurance companies may require me work within their fee structure. While my fees remain constant, final charges may be adjusted to account for insurance rates of reimbursements, required write offs, etc.

Initial Diagnostic Interview CPT Code: 90791	The initial 50-60 minute visit, including account set-up, filling out insurance forms, and treatment plans.	\$190.00
Individual Psychotherapy CPT Code: 90832	25-30 minutes with patient and/or family member	\$120.00
Individual Psychotherapy CPT Code: 90834	45-50 minute individual counseling session. This is the most common service charge.	\$160.00
Individual Psychotherapy CPT Code: 90837	60 minute individual counseling session. This is billed if the session exceeds the usual 50 minutes.	\$190.00
Conjoint/Family Psychotherapy CPT Codes: 90846 or 90847	45-50 minute couple or family counseling session, with or without the patient present.	\$160.00
Interactive Complexity Add-On CPT Code: 90785	This code can be added if the visit is unusually complex (i.e., needing an interpreter, multiple people in the room, special equipment, etc.).	\$30.00
Neurobehavioral Status Examination CPT Code: 96116	The initial 50-60 minute visit when the visit is based on suspected neurological condition. More in-depth neurocognitive testing may be planned. This visit includes history taking, records review, and limited cognitive assessment.	\$190.00
Psychological or Neuropsychological Testing CPT Codes: 96101, 96102, 96116, 96118, 96119	Performed by psychologist, technician, or computer. Includes interviewing, records review, administration, scoring, interpretation, and report writing. Typically, the total number of professional hours required are bundled and billed to insurance with final diagnosis on the date the final report is prepared.	\$160.00
